ORDER-IN-ORIGINAL

- 1.1 Any person aggrieved by this order may, under Section 11(2) read with Section 15(1) of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 file an appeal against the same to the appropriate appellate authority i.e. to the Additional Director General of Foreign Trade, 4th floor, Shastry Bhawan, Haddows Road, Nungambakkam, Chennai PIN 600 006, within 45 days from the date of serving of this Adjudication Order. A copy of this order and a complete set of evidence relied upon in support of such appeal in the form of an Annexure should be enclosed therewith. A copy of Appeal filed, if any, may be simultaneously forwarded to the undersigned to enable supply of records to Appellate Authority.
- 1.2 Any person desirous of filing an appeal against this order shall deposit the penalty amount and produce proof of payment along with appeal to the Appellate authority failing which the appeal is liable to be rejected for non-compliance of the provision of Section 15(1) of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992.
- 1.3 The penalty amount is to be deposited under the Head of Account "1453 Foreign Trade & Export Promotion Minor Head 102-Other receipts, fines and penalties etc., Director General of Foreign Trade or by way of a DD payable at Bangalore drawn in favour of Jt. Director General of Foreign Trade, Bangalore within 45 days thereof.
- 2 Whereas **M/s.V.R.Enterprises** (Import-Export Code No. **0709008333**) a proprietorship concern (herein after referred to as the 'licensee firm') Proprietor Sri Ravi Singhania had applied for issue of **DFIA** for import of duty free import item viz. 4500Kgs of Mulberry Raw silk for a CIF value Rs.74,02,500/- (US\$157,500) and proposed to export 3237.410KGs of 100% Natural Silk (Chinnon/Crepe/Georgette/ Taffeta/ Satin) Fabrics/Madeups/Sarees having

net content of MRS 3237.410KGs for FOB value Rs.88,83,000/-(US\$1,89,000) under file no.07/21/76/00314/AM10 dated 18.12.2009 under J 123 of SION.

3. A show cause notice was issued to the licensee firm by the Commissioner of Customs, Cochin regarding misdeclaration of consignment covered by invoice no.VRE/EXP/03/09-10 dated 08.01.2010, attached to shipping bill no.1643968 dated 11.01.2010 filed under the Duty Free Import Authorisation (DFIA) file no. 07/21/076/00314/AM10 dated 18.12.2009 in respect of description, quantity, quality, value etc. and are being attempted to export in violation of Customs Act, 1962 Foreign Trade (Development and Regulation) Act 1992 and Foreign Trade (Regulation) Rules 1993. This was also in violation of the DFIA Scheme.

The firm had tried to export cut-pieces made out of used sarees of different designs/patterns and a portion of them were torn in the guise of 100%Natural Silk Chiffon /Chinnon /Crepe/georgette/ Taffeta/Satin Fabrics/Madeups sarees declare value of Rs.59,71,600 (FOB) declared net weight of 2146.800KGs and gross weight of 2275Kgs. vide Invoice no.VRE/EXP/03/09-10 dated 8.1.2010 dated 07.01.2010 thereby eligible for import of 2984Kgs duty free import of Mulberry raw silk (Gummed) and attempted to evade Customs duty. The firm had packed only 1087Kgs of silk scarves and to make the weight tally, consignment was packed with 1033Kgs of base boards between the silk scarves. The seized cloth pieces was assed at Rs.27,175/- and baseboard at Rs.10,330/-

4. The Commissioner of Customs, Cochin imposed on the licensee firm as penalty of Rs.15,00,000/-(Rs. Fifteen lakhs only) and Redemption fine Rs.1,00,000/-(Rupees One lakh) vide Order No.16/2010 dated 04.11.2010 for attempting to export 1087Kgs of old and soiled fabric valued at Rs.27175/- in the guise of 100% Natural Silk Scarves/Curtains/Blankets(Silk Madeups) at a declared value of Rs.59,71,600/- attempted to be exported vide Shipping Billno.1643968 dated 11.01.2010.

5. As per letter dated 2.3.2010 issued by Directorate General of Foreign Trade, New Delhi, and based on the Report of Special Intelligence & Investigation Branch, Office of the Commissioner of Customs, Cochin vide letter no. SIIB/MISC/5/2010-Cus dated 21.01.2010, the firm was kept under Denied Entity List.

6. Under the provisions of Section 13 & 14 of Foreign Trade (Development and Regulation) Act, 1992 licence firm was issued a show cause notice as to

a) Why a penalty should not be imposed on you under Section 11(2) of Foreign Trade (Development and Regulation) Act, 1992,

b) Why you should not continued to be placed under denied entity list denying further issue of any benefits as per Rule 7 of Foreign Trade (Regulation) Rules,1993. No one from the licensee firm has appeared for a personal hearing on 8.8.2013.

7. In view of the above facts, the undersigned has come to the conclusion that the firm has tried to cheat the Government of India and employed fraudulent practice for the purpose of exporting goods with intention to gain undue benefits by way duty free imports. The firm and its Proprietor are guilty of committing breach law and procedure relating to Foreign Trade (D & R) Act, 1992, including DFIA Scheme concerned under the Foreign Trade Policy.

8. Therefore in exercise of powers vested in undersigned under Section 11(2) read with Section 13 of Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act 1992 hereby impose a penalty of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) upon the firm M/s.V.R.Enterprises(Prop. Shri Ravi Singhania), Lalitha Mannor, No.12, flat no.G.C.,14th cross, A.E.C.S Layout,Sanjay Nagar, Bangalore 560 094.

9. The firm is continued to be placed under Denied Entity list denying further issue of any benefits as per Rule 7(1) and (n) of Foreign Trade (Regulation) Rules 1993.

10. This order is without prejudice to any other action that may be taken against the firm under any other law as applicable.
